



PARENT INFORMATION

Parents, please plan to dress children appropriately. We suggest long pants, play clothes and old shoes since they might get dirty. If it's a rainy day, raincoats, boots and umbrella are suggested. We still do the tours in the rain.

Children with allergies to "bees" should bring medication with them. No straw or hay is used on wagons for the benefit of people with those allergies.

We do not allow parents to tag along in their own cars, without prior approval from the school. The guest count schools have given us tell us how many wagons and guides your children need to be safe and comfortable. We cannot accommodate last minute additional adults.

All are welcome in our store (Big Barn). Students must always be accompanied by an adult.

BAD WEATHER
